**FINDHORN AT THE MORAY FIRTH**



Findhorn is a small old fishing village at the Findhorn Bay on a peninsula into the Moray Firth in the north of Scotland. 'Findhorn' also stands for the 46-year-old intentional community on a spiritual base, including an eco-village. At its core is the Findhorn Foundation, with a living education workshop-centre-in-community.

The Findhorn Bay and Moray Firth present a beautiful sight with its wide beaches and untouched dunelands full of wild plants, but our view is wider than that. A lot of the printing is done locally, as we believe in creating sustainability in our local area. The card and paper is recycled as much as possible and our printer has won several eco-awards for their ecological way of working.

Findhorn Images is a small business, in premises at The Park, Findhorn. It's amazing what can all be created in a small space! Some of our storage space is in Findhorn village.

The creative and art-directional work is done by Adriana Sjan Bijman, who is a photographer/graphic designer/artist, working and living since 1998 in Scotland. European, born Dutch, she studied art in Amsterdam and lived in 4 other European countries before choosing Moray as her base.



Adriana has worked for half a year in India and kept contact with a small paperfactory, where our handmade paper originates from as a fair trade. Several other community people work for Findhorn Images and together we create the products with lots of love and joy – to spread the message of the beauty and preciousness of nature and our whole planet.

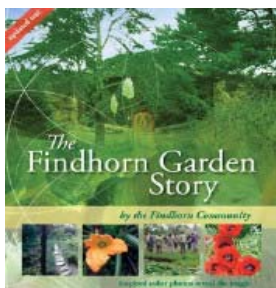

In the harvest month of September the Findhorn Foundation Community hosted some workshops of American herbalist Susan Weed and later on Frank Cook, the herbalist from Schumacher College. Frank took us on some fascinating 'weed walks' as well as extolling the virtues of fermentation, and offering insights into the abundance of Nature. As participant Dan Pulett (co-worker of Trees for Life) said afterwards: "Frank is a very inspiring, authentic teacher with a deep connection to Nature. He emphasized how important it is for everyone to have a deeper understanding of wild foods, medicines etc, empowering us at a time when we must inevitably move towards a more local and self-reliant scale." A Wild-Life-Network group was set up in Findhorn to exchange skills and knowledge..... Beach comber Adriana started her seaweed-research!
